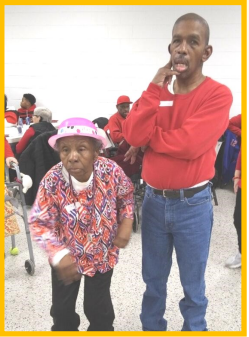
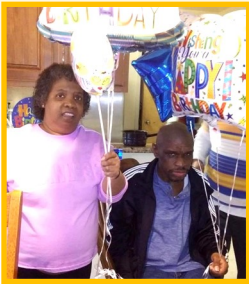
ARC / UCP GROUP HOMES

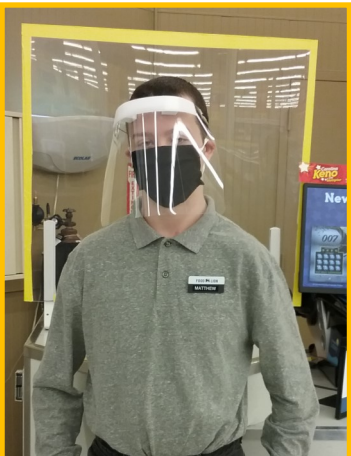
