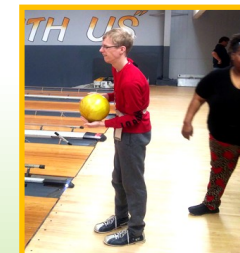

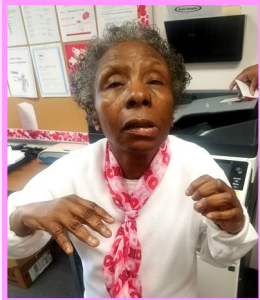

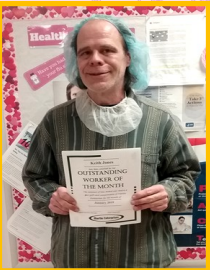
VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION

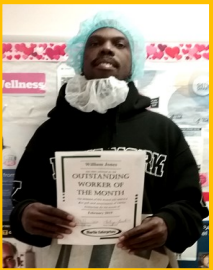

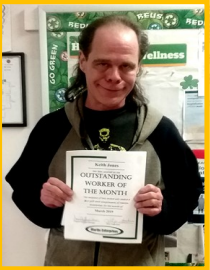
