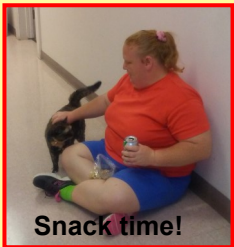

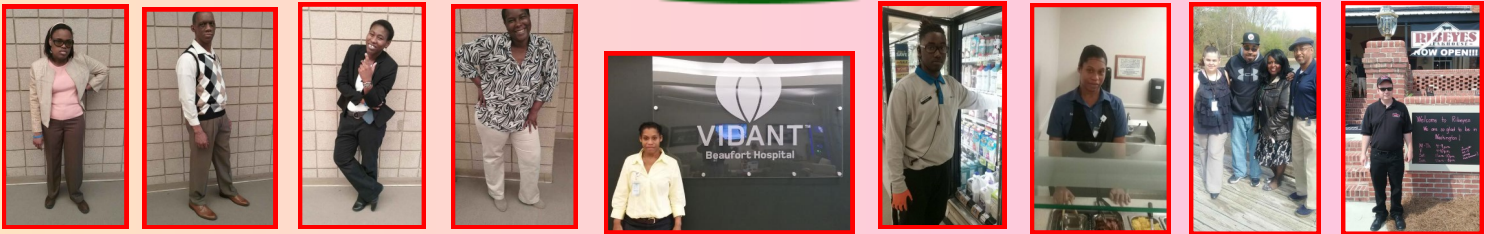

This fiscal year has proven to be another success. We have gained nine Work Adjustment placements and two Supported Employment placements this quarter.

A special thank you is extended to all employers that have helped our consumers in finding employment.

We continue to partner with our local NC Works Department to seek employment for our consumers. Our monthly VR client meetings continue to play an important role in preparing individuals for work. Each month at the client meetings a person is selected for Worker of the Month based upon excellence in Attendance, Productivity, Cooperation, Attitude, and Behavior. The WRAP program, out of Greenville, continues to provide innovative ideas and words of encouragement for our clients.

In May, the VR Department partnered with The Martin/Bertie County Re-Entry Council to assist individuals in the community with criminal records to obtain a second chance at employment. It is our hope to continue to help break down barriers for our clients.

The second quarter Success Club Meeting will be held at the Regal Grande Theater on July 31<sup>st</sup> due to scheduling conflicts in June. Participants will be provided with lunch afterwards in Greenville. CES Cooper will be heading up the Success Club Outings.
