


CHRISTMAS

VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION

This quarter, the Vocational Rehabilitation department placed six Work Adjustment clients and one Supported Employment client on jobs in their communities. Stella's Café of Plymouth, Clara Manor of Washington, Solid Foundations, and Perdue have contributed to our success for the current quarter. HTM Concepts also hired a client as a Clipper. A special thank you is extended to all employers that have aided our consumers in obtaining employment.

Martin Enterprises has partnered with Martin General Hospital and Martin Community College to start a pilot program providing onsite training through our Vocational Evaluation service. North Carolina Division of Vocational Rehabilitation Services will be discontinuing in-house Work Adjustment Training services in 2021 to allow broader training skills to be obtained in local communities. Individuals will be trained for a variety of work skills not limited to, but including janitorial, serving, stocking, filing, food prep, and customer service. We look forward to this venture being a success and providing additional opportunities for our consumers.


